

THE ATTRIBUTES OF A MAN

Rank how well you currently live each one of these out in your life:

ONE I A MAN SUBMITS TO AUTHORITY

Submission is an attitude that results from a mindset. The man who excels at this understands that he cannot self-govern and needs to be governed. Therefore, he gives up his will to a greater authority that is objective to his own. While many men will run from authority, the only winners are the ones who give in to the authority of Jesus Christ. To effectively build this attitude we need a changed mindset. One that denies self, embraces missional suffering, and is subordinate in identity.



TWO | WILLING TO MAKE HARD SACRIFICES

While it is natural to be a taker, God's man is a giver. He understands that God is a generous giver who gave the ultimate sacrifice for all men. He believes that Christ's sacrifice is the means of his salvation, but sacrifice is also the method of his sanctification. This attribute requires self-evaluation, radical priority, renewed positioning, an attitude that is willing, and a mindset that loses everything to win that of real value.



THREE | RADICALLY OBEDIENT

A man invites obedience to God's moral code because he understands that morality exists outside of himself. He can obey God even when he is uncomfortable and cannot see the whole picture, because he knows that his obedience is a living act of faith and trust in God. Obedience and disobedience will reveal a man's true character.



FOUR I STRATEGIZES SELF-DISCIPLINE

He will use self-discipline as a means of accomplishing God's purposes in his life, understanding that the flesh prefers indifference over discipline. The goal is to keep the prize in sight while becoming more obedient to the Spirit and less obedient to our flesh. The end goal is always to fulfill the purposes of God. In the private place of a man's life he exhibits this in prayer, study, reflection, confession, service, worship, and fasting as the chief disciplines.



FIVE I RECEPTIVE TO TRUTH

Corruption in this world is evidence that we struggle to live in and know the truth. Truth for man is only found in God, and His words. God's Word, the Bible, is our truest guide and one resource we should reach for in every decision, challenge, and temptation. A man should receive this truth before his own intuitions, emotions, and opinions. In addition, he is willing to admit when he is wrong when confronted by truth. He does this by being sensitive to the Spirit.





SIX I LIVES PURPOSEFULLY

As a man is desperate to discover his purpose, he knows that God is the single provider of purpose and that Christ's call to "follow me" was the primary means of discovering purpose. Because of this he rightly prioritizes his identity in Christ before all other things including his possessions and his profession. He understands that his unique spiritual gifts are a means to discovering purpose, and that living these out in community reveals purpose and mission.

He will welcome the activities of pruning and connecting as central growth activities that benefit him and the kingdom.
